The workshop will provide a forum to hear and discuss the impact on parents of having a baby who is born prematurely and consequently spends their first days, weeks, or even months in a Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU)/Special Care Baby Unit (SCBU). It will also offer the opportunity to talk about working parents and babies who have been through this experience through looking at clinical cases/vignettes.
