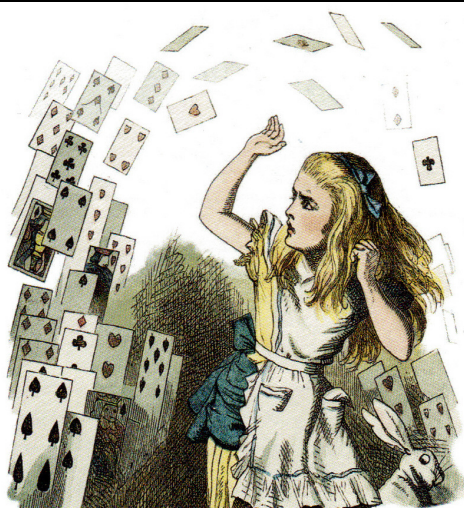

This October’s event will focus on the following key areas:-

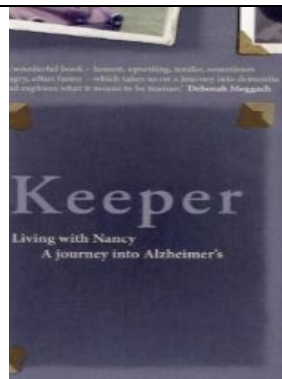
- Seeing the person, not the dementia.
